**CANCELLATION OF BOIL WATER NOTICE**

On January 22, 2020, you were notified to boil all tap water used for drinking and cooking purposes, as a precautionary measure, due to a loss of system pressure while trying to repair a rupture in the mainline that serves the above-mentioned addresses. The FPPUD replaced a portion of the broken water main on that same day. The impacted portions of the distribution system were disinfected and flushed, after pressurizing the water main. Two (2) bacteriological samples were collected on January 23, 2020, from the distribution system, and both samples tested negative for total coliform bacteria.

The FPPUD in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water, has determined that, through abatement of the health hazard and bacteriological testing of the water, your water is now considered safe to drink. **It is no longer necessary to boil your tap water or for you to consume bottled water.**
